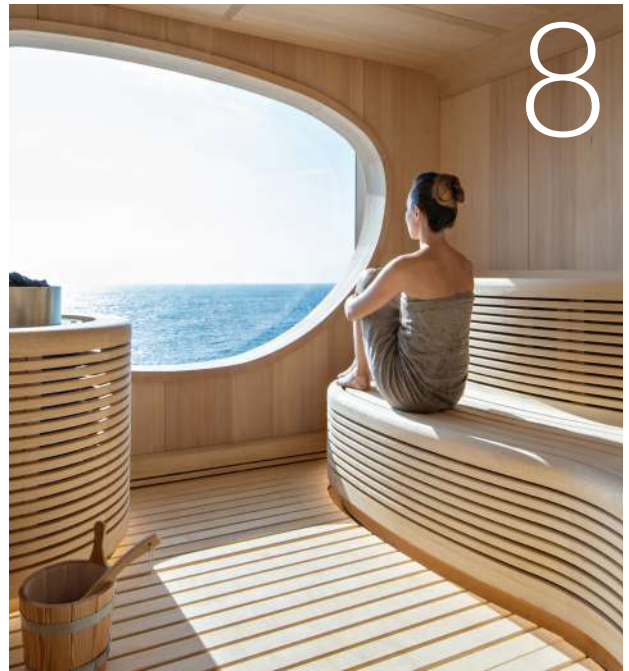

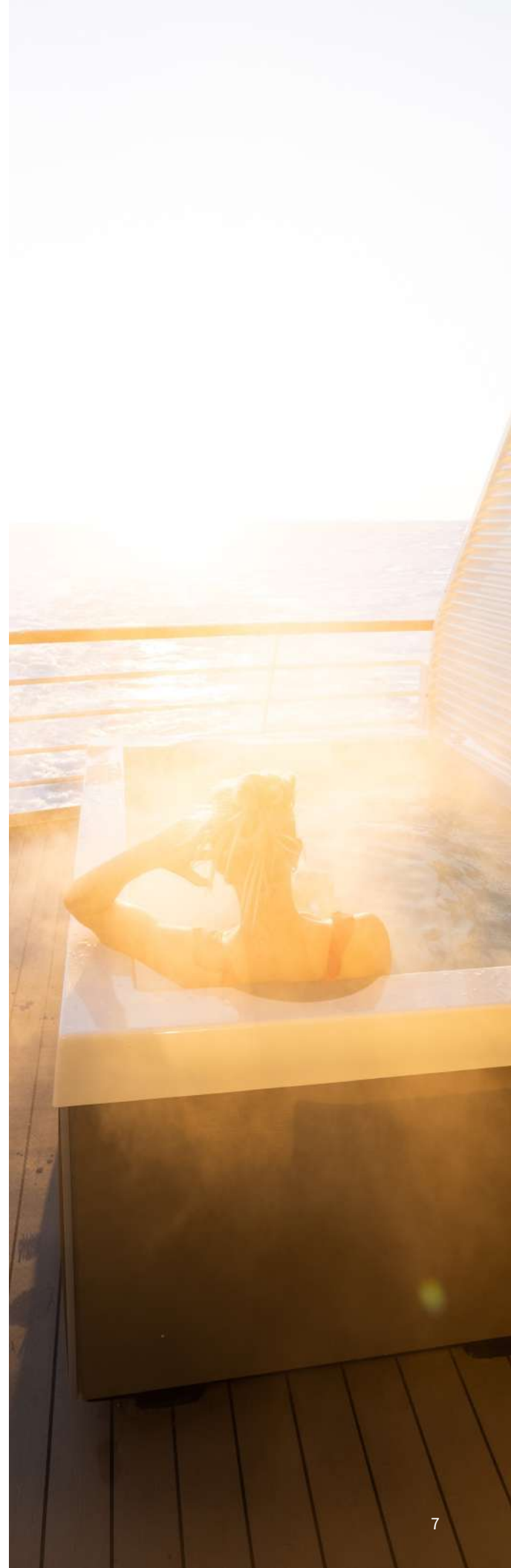

BEYOND GREEN

Purpose-built for more responsible exploration, PONANT EXPLORATIONS ships feature the latest technologies and, in many areas, exceed the industry's highest environmental standards. Each of the Sisterships, PONANT Explorer Series, and the Icebreaker *Le Commandant Charcot* is certified "Clean Ships" by Bureau Veritas, one of the world's foremost stewards of ecologically sound travel.

Our commitment for a more sustainable tourism includes a strategy to optimize environmental performance and ensure we can:

- cut carbon emissions by 40% with a silent electric propulsion system.
- keep in a fixed location on the seas without need of an anchor with a sophisticated GPS and propulsion system, called Dynamic Positioning.
- conserve, filter, treat, and recycle all water used.
- treat wastewater with advanced filtration systems.
- sort, compact, and store all waste aboard for recycling ashore.
- use CFR and LED lighting throughout ships, which uses 10% of the electrical power of older systems.
- keep distance from marine animals via advanced sonar that provides the bridge with rolling 3D views of the ocean floor, icebergs, and ice floes.

SUPPORTING SCIENCE AT SEA

PONANT EXPLORATIONS actively supports scientific research, facilitating projects and providing our vessels in some of the most inaccessible regions of the globe, especially in the polar areas.

This support has led to the development of numerous studies across a wide range of disciplines, from geophysics to ecology and marine pollution. Thanks to our regular presence in the Arctic and Antarctic, PONANT EXPLORATIONS has become a vital link between science and the poles.

Through PONANT Science, researchers from around the world embark our ships to study the ocean—Earth's least understood ecosystem. With two onboard labs and rare polar access, *Le Commandant Charcot* enables vital work in regions once considered unreachable. Travel and science move forward together.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What languages are spoken aboard?

All communications and announcements are in English and French. The crew are bilingual; they all speak English and French. Signs are in English and French. Excursions and explorations are offered in English and French. Select sailings are curated for English speaking travelers only.

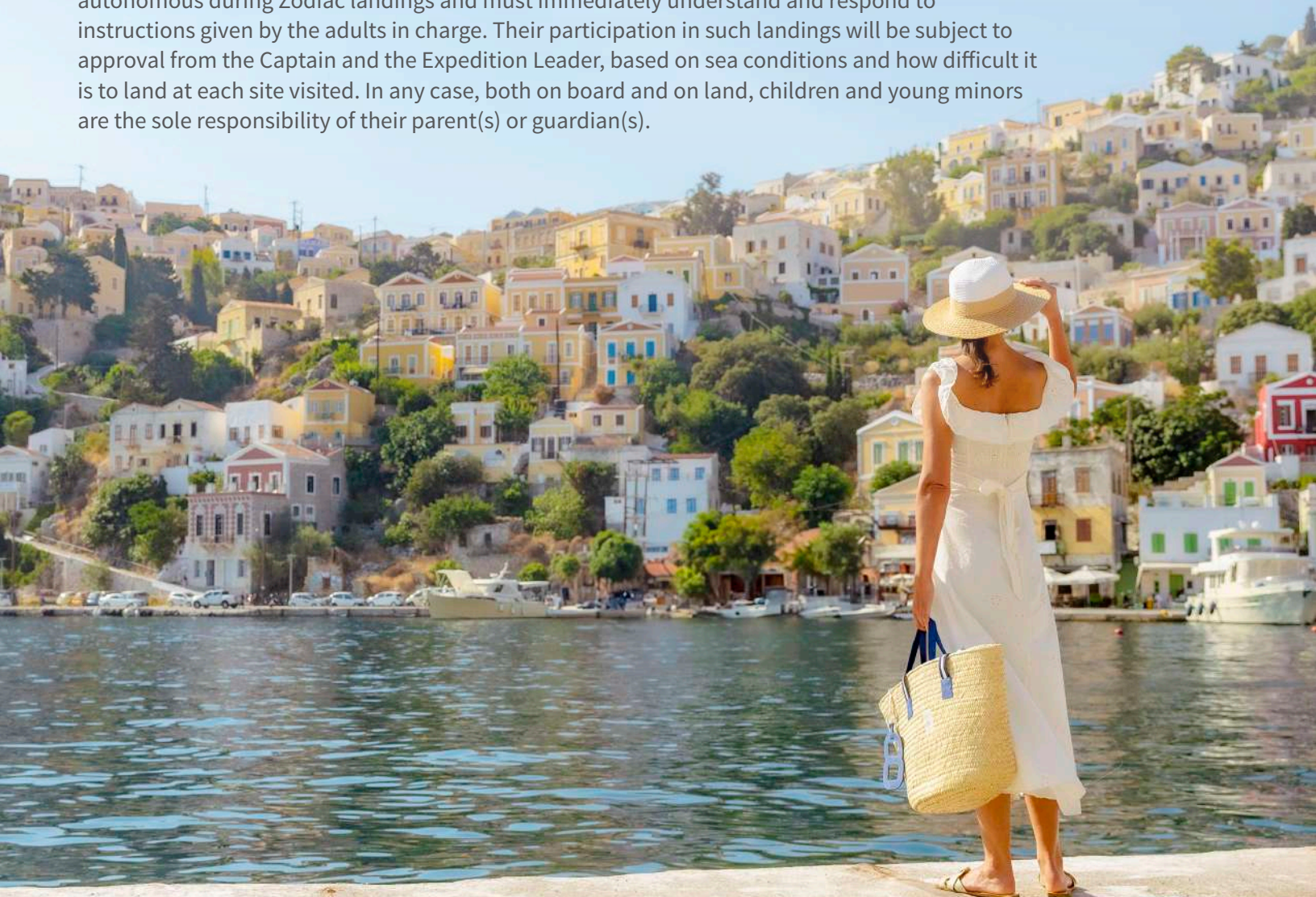
Must single travelers always pay a supplement?

No, many voyages offer either a reduced supplement or no single supplement for solo travelers.

Are children welcome on the ship?

Children must be 8 years or older to board *Le Commandant Charcot*. Children must be 6 years or older to board an expedition (except aboard *Le Commandant Charcot*). Children must be 1 year or older on all non-expedition sailings. There is a limit of five children, aged 1 to 6 years, per departure. Kid's Club is available to children age 4 and up only, on select summer sailings in Europe.

During all expeditions, including to the Arctic and Antarctic, children must be completely autonomous during Zodiac landings and must immediately understand and respond to instructions given by the adults in charge. Their participation in such landings will be subject to approval from the Captain and the Expedition Leader, based on sea conditions and how difficult it is to land at each site visited. In any case, both on board and on land, children and young minors are the sole responsibility of their parent(s) or guardian(s).



Do the power sockets on board comply with North American & European standards?

Yes, 220 volt alternating current at 50 Hz is supplied through power sockets that meet European standards. The electricity on board is 220 volt AC (European standard), with 110 volt AC (North American standard) in stateroom bathrooms. We recommend guests bring an adapter and a converter. For safety reasons, the use of personal irons and hair irons is not allowed.

Is smoking allowed on board?

All enclosed areas (lounge areas, dining room, staterooms, reception area, etc.) are non-smoking. Smoking is not permitted on balconies. Smoking is allowed in the ship's designated outdoor areas.

Is tipping compulsory?

Tipping is included in the fare. Additional tips to staff, crew, and spa therapists are at the discretion of the guest.

Is there a laundry service aboard the ships?

Yes, a steward or stewardess is available to take care of guests' laundry needs. Washing and ironing of clothing takes 24 to 48 hours. Same-day service is only available for ironing. Dry cleaning is not available. Laundry service is available for an additional charge.

Can purchases be made on board?

Gifts and souvenirs can be purchased in our boutique on board. Please note that the law requires us to close the boutique while we are at a port of call.

Can PONANT EXPLORATIONS book air, pre- and post-cruise hotels, and transfers?

Yes, a la carte and package options are available on select sailings. On select sailings transfers from the airport to the ship and/or from the ship to the airport on embarkation and/or disembarkation day may be included. On select sailings, flight(s) may be included, based on availability at the time of booking. Flight schedule is indicated on the electronic ticket included in the travel documents. Contact us for details.

What is the deposit policy?

A deposit of 25% of the fare is required within 72 hours of booking to confirm a reservation.

What is the final payment policy?

- Unless otherwise noted, final payment must be received up to 90 days prior to date of travel.
- Final payment must be received within 48 hours of booking for bookings made 89 to 30 days prior to sailing.
- For reservations made 29 days or less prior to sailings; full and final payment will be due at the time of booking.
- The cruise line reserves the right to cancel any booking not fully paid at final payment due date.
- Payment may be made by bank wire, personal check, American Express, Visa or MasterCard. Once a deposit is made, all changes are subject to an administrative/cancellation fee.

What is the cancellation policy?

Deposited reservations that are canceled are subject to the following charges:

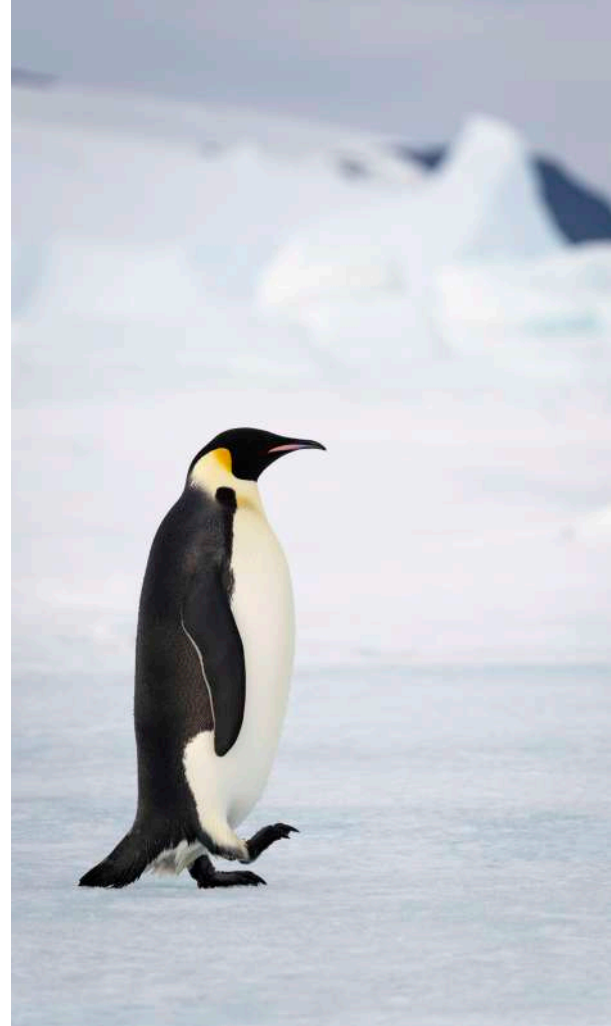
- Within 15 days of deposit: No fee*
- 365 days or more prior to departure date: *\$250 Administrative Fee per guest, can be applied to a future booking within 12 months of cancellation date
- 364 to 211 days prior to departure date: 10% of full fare, per guest, can be applied to a future booking within 12 months of cancellation
- 210 to 91 days prior to departure date: 25% of full fare, per guest
- 90 days or less prior to departure date: 100% of full fare, per guest

There is no grace period after 90 days. Bookings not paid in full at 90 days (or 30 days with prior policy) are subject to cancellation. Final payment must be received 90 days prior to voyage departure date. Cancellation terms apply to the cruise fare only. Payments can be transferred to an alternative booking up to 120 days of sailing. Airfare and pre/post hotel stays are subject to fees depending on the cancellation date. Airline tickets are issued 75 days prior to sailing. A cancellation penalty will apply to all airline tickets cancelled after issuance. **Does not apply to bookings made within 90 days of sail date or that require full payment (whichever comes first).*

Can a direct booking be transferred to a Travel Advisor?

Bookings can only be transferred to a TA within 60 days of the original booking date. All transfer requests must be submitted in writing by the guest. This guideline applies only to bookings outside of 90 days prior to sailing.

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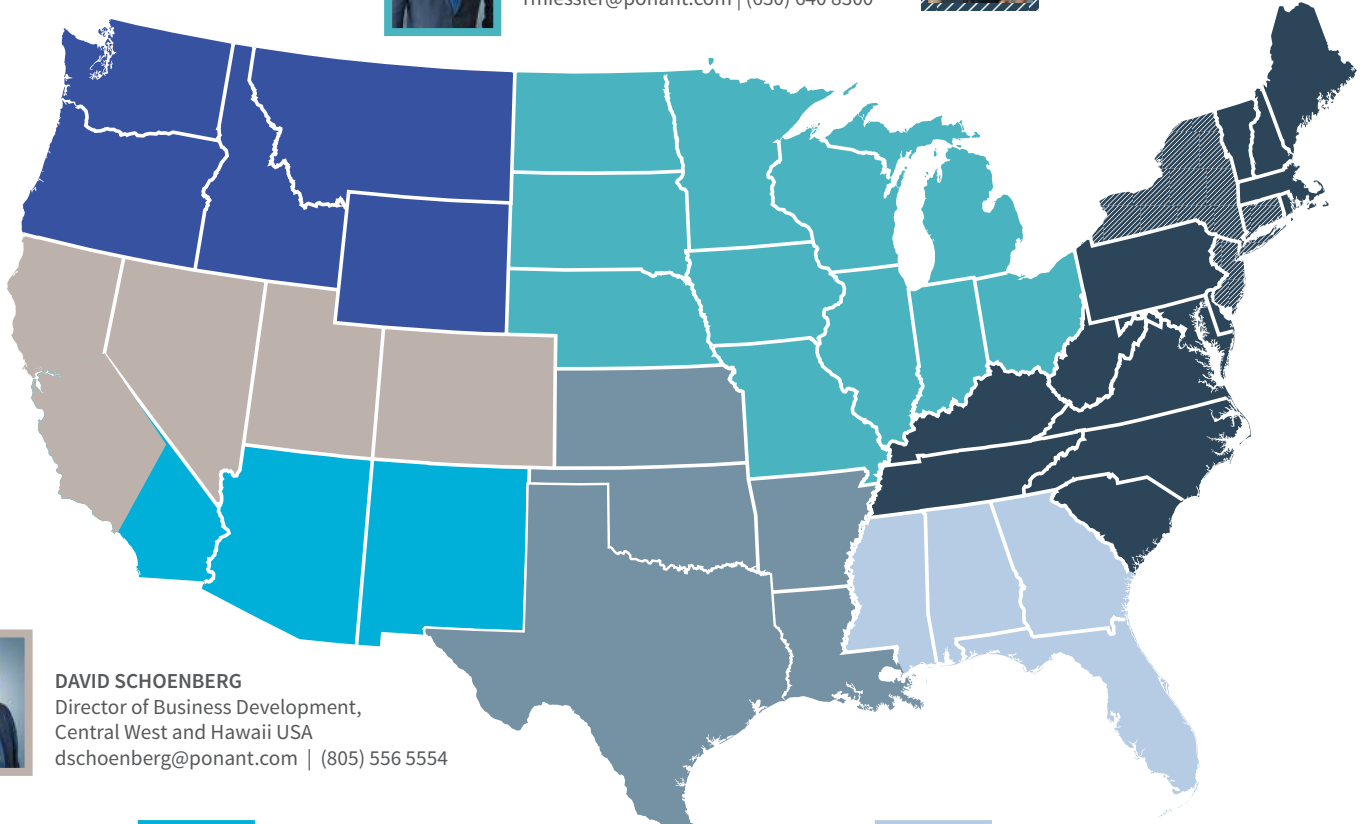
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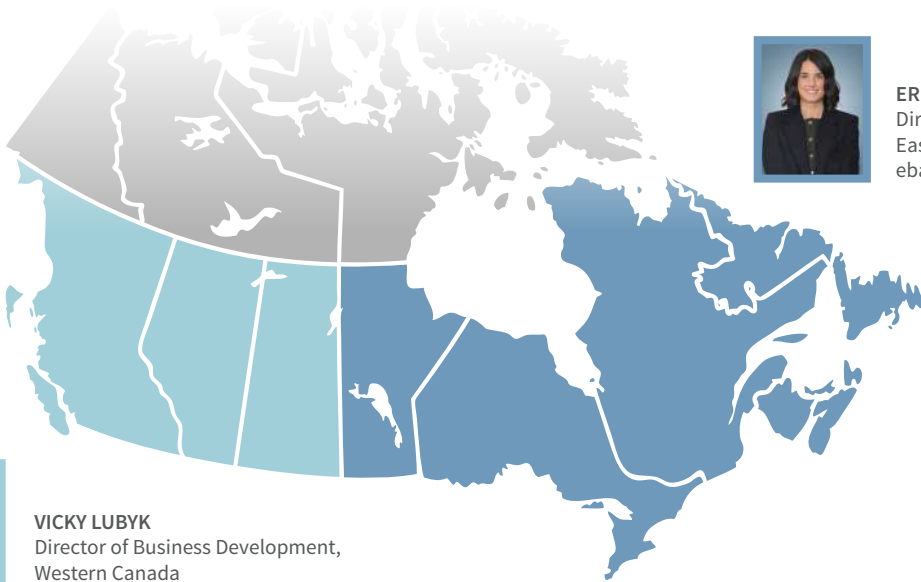
